PURPOSE:

To lead small groups program, develop and direct the discipleship team, oversee marriage ministry, recruit and develop leaders for discipleship programs, and resource discipleship initiatives.

I. Discipleship Champion

- 1. Lead discipleship initiatives at ALIVE
- 2. Represent Discipleship to the greater church body
 - a. Guest Connection events, core night, discovery class, Sunday AM promotion
 - b. Champion cause of adult discipleship among staff
- 3. Ensure ALIVE Discipleship programs replicate ALIVE DNA and lead to multiplication

II. Small Groups Direction

- 1. Oversee and coordinate small groups system
 - a. Meet monthly with Discipleship Team to facilitate small groups
 - b. Train new leaders
 - c. Coordinate details for online small group catalog
 - d. Oversee small group launches
 - e. Recruit discipleship team members and small group leaders
- 2. Facilitate leadership development for Discipleship volunteers
 - a. Provide strategic, development-oriented trainings and appreciation
 - b. Empower discipleship team members to lead and care for group leaders and to own the vision for discipleship at ALIVE
- 3. Serve as liaison between staff and Discipleship Team
 - a. Transfer and champion ALIVE DNA in Discipleship Teams at every level
 - b. Resource and advocate for church-wide adult discipleship initiatives
 - c. Communicate church-wide emphasis to discipleship team and groups

III. Baptism and New Believers' Coordination

- 1. Plan details of baptism
 - a. Work with other staff to set dates, and cover details for baptism day
 - b. Coordinate with youth and children's pastors and communication to pastoral staff

- 2. Create Baptism class for candidates
 - a. Teach on meaning of baptism
 - b. Manage sign ups and follow ups for class
- 3. Follow-up with baptism candidates
 - a. Printing certificates
 - b. Assist new believers in finding support needed for the next step

IV. Marriage Ministry Coordination

- 1. Support vision of ALIVE through marriage ministry
 - a. Share marriage ministry as outreach resource and care/discipleship resource internally
 - b. Incorporate marriage transformation stories into body life
 - c. Champion marriage ministry to staff and ALIVE as a whole
- 2. Support and resource marriage ministry leaders
 - a. Work with ministry leaders to find testimony couples
 - b. Provide childcare guidance, books, materials as needed
 - c. Communicate regarding technical needs for Re|engage

V. Support Discipleship Initiatives for Campus Pastors

- 1. Resource and inform campuses of Discipleship ministries
 - a. Share groups system and resources with campuses
 - b. Provide support with Re|engage launches (testimonies, access to videos)
- 2. Work with campus pastors to contextualize discipleship events or initiatives as needed

VI. Stephen Ministry, Celebrate Recovery and Grief Care Support (Help Ministries)

- 1. Provide resources for ministries
- 2. Meet with ministry leaders regularly to provide support, training, encouragement and accountability
- 2. Ensure follow up for all ministry sign ups
- 3. Communicate with staff and body regarding these help ministries

VII. Promotion

- 1. Propose content and strategy for discipleship promotion to communications department
- 2. Initiate internal discipleship promotion
- 3. Provide clear communication and direction to staff regarding discipleship initiatives
 - a. Write up discipleship program descriptions and communications
 - b. Share clearly in staff planning meetings

VIII. Data Management

- 1. Record and report data for all discipleship initiatives (groups, marriage, etc)
 - a. Manage sign ups and follow ups for discipleship initiatives
 - b. Maintain accurate lists and counts
- 2. Maintain discipleship data
 - a. Work with group leaders to keep accurate group records
 - b. Add new contacts and update existing contacts for discipleship sign ups
- 3. Maintain group and discipleship data systems
 - a. Train leaders on discipleship systems
 - b. Maintain sign up system for groups
