# — MORALITY PART ONE —

What do you think of when you hear the word Morality?

If someone asked you where you get your sense of right/wrong from, what would you say?

## ***Universal Human Condition:***

All people have within themselves \_\_\_\_\_ that push them toward certain behaviors.

Our universal human condition is that we have a variety of instincts always pushing and pulling us; but there is some sense that we can't just \_\_\_\_\_ all of them simply whenever we want.

The very existence of words like \_\_\_\_\_, \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ prove that at our most basic level we all assume some standard of behavior.
