ALIVE WESLEYAN STUDENT MINISTRIES

AWSM (ALIVE Wesleyan Student Ministries) exists to lead students (grades 6-12) to come ALIVE as they own their Faith, their Church, and their role in God's mission! We do this by inviting students into:

- Deep involvement in the life of ALIVE.
- Regular engagement in Wednesday night services (6:30-8:00pm).
- Living as part of a small group.
- Serving regularly.
- Sharing the Gospel of Jesus in their spheres of influence.

As Project 20 develops, AWSM has the opportunity to engage with more students than ever, in more places than ever before, and with more effectiveness. As a part of the overall ALIVE vision, AWSM is increasing opportunities for small groups, midweek services, and schools outreach in towns and cities beyond our current footprint.

CURRENT NEEDS:

- Worship Team Help lead students in passionate worship of God through your gifts, excellence, and heart for God. This role is rotation based.
- Worship Tech Set the stage for worship, teaching, and fun through sound, media design, and meticulous execution of behind the scenes preparation.
- Small Group Leaders Invest in the lives of our students through consistent meeting times, clear communication with parents, and getting to know and loving each student in your care.
- Check-In Team When our students and parents arrive on a
 Wednesday night, our check-in team are the first smiling faces they'll
 meet! From setting up the tent, packing guest gifts, and being excited to
 see students, our check-in team is crucial for our Wednesday large
 group meetings!
- Hosts People want to feel comfortable and welcome in new places.
 Nothing helps that happen faster than a friendly person who notices you. This is where hosting begins. Hosts help answer questions, introduce guests to other students, and ensure that guests have the best chance to plug in to AWSM.

Overtime Team - After a full night of fun, worship, spiritual challenge, and making friends, snacks and drinks help students take a moment to process before getting in the car and answering the question, "How was youth? What did you learn?" that inevitably awaits. Overtime is that moment; grab a snack - pizza rolls, nachos, soda floats, popcorn bar, waffles, etc. - and take a moment to chill before you go home. This also gives our volunteers a chance to connect with students before they tackle the rest of their week. This team helps plan, purchase, prep, serve, and clean up our Overtime experience.

*As our attendance increases at our midweek services, AWSM may need to prepare to begin meeting in a larger venue. This means we'll need to expand each area of our ministry and prepare for a higher level of production, setup, and followup.

*As we attempt to engage students more regularly, and with greater depth, technology, social media, and event hosting efforts will become more necessary than ever. This means we need people who love photography, video production, front/back-stage production, and social media engagement.

*As AWSM seeks to engage with students in "their sphere of influence," places like schools, sporting events, clubs, and hangouts in our region will be places of incredible opportunity for our leaders to meet, support, and equip students. This means we'll be looking for people who love engaging in schools, cheering people on, coaching Rec-league teams, and getting into the lives of our community teens - on their level.





ALIVE WESLEYAN CARE MINISTRIES

A normal life has moments that are great, and moments that are not. Most moments are somewhere in between. ALIVE believes life is best lived in a community that walks with us through all of it. And, we take seriously the command to be close to people in their best and worst moments.

The CARE Team is built to accomplish one goal: pair your gifts, passions, and abilities to pair them with tangible needs that arise in our community. Once you've signed up, you'll be put on our "roster" of caregivers and alerted when a need matches your profile.

CURRENT NEEDS:

- Pre-Marital Mentor Couple Mentor couples exist to help walk with engaged couples as they prepare for marriage. All mentor couples will receive training. Mentor couples meet once a month (or more!) with their engaged couple to allow time for intentional fellowship and relationship building.
- Personalized Care Givers This is an organized program to provide highquality, one-to-one, Christ-centered care to people in the congregation and the community experiencing life's difficulties. Care-givers must complete 50 hours of high-impact training and an interview and application process.
- Pastoral Care Team Part of our three tiered approach to CARE If you have training or experience in ministry, chaplaincy, or feel God may be calling you to begin caring for the spiritual needs of those in crisis, this team may be for you. These members show up in the highest of highs and lowest of lows.
 Specific training and qualification is required.
- Visitation Team Visit patients at area hospitals and other medical institutions.
- Home Visitors Visit senior adults at home who are mostly shut in.
- Drivers Provide transportation for senior adults for medical visits, home needs and church.

ADULT DISCIPLESHIP

In discipleship people begin to grasp a personal relationship with Jesus and embrace who Jesus has called them to become. Through various discipleship opportunities people can find Christian community, develop their gifts, and be equipped to serve and lead others.

Over the next five years the discipleship ministries will be a sending hub for ALIVE, as missional leaders develop and launch out into new areas of personal and community ministry. If you love walking with others as they discover God, grow in their gifts, and experience transformation, you will love serving in discipleship.

CURRENT NEEDS:

- Administration Volunteers Every number is a person and every person has a story.
 Help provide excellent communication to every person by diving into the details.
 Projects could include baptism mailings, 4D follow up, data entry, sign up management and more!
- Childcare Liaisons When kids are cared for, parents can engage. Help manage details, secure childcare, organize and plan behind the scenes for discipleship events. If you love details and love people, this is a great way to serve kids and parents.
- Leader Couples Invest in awesome marriages and serve with your spouse. This is a
 great role for couples passionate about building healthy marriages through a small group
 environment. Leader couples lead small groups through Relengage marriage ministry.
- Small Group Leaders/Hosts Create a healthy community with a few friends and invite
 others in! Whether you're talking about sermons or connecting through an activity, group
 leaders help build community at ALIVE.
- Sound and Technology Volunteers Sets up and runs sound and slides for adult discipleship events hosted at ALIVE on various evenings throughout the year.
- Class Hosts Set the stage for people to learn and connect in engaging environments.
 Take care of refreshments, room decor (as needed), and environment prep for 4D's,
 Hubs, or other Discipleship classes.
- Celebrate Recovery Leaders Invest in the lives of those seeking to break free from life's hurts, habits and hang-ups. CR meets weekly on Monday evenings.

OPERATIONS

Operations is responsible for creating environments that support the various ministries of ALIVE. Our goal is create attractive and welcoming spaces for groups and events to take place within.

CURRENT NEEDS:

- Facility Set Up and Tear Down Assist with setting up prior to, and cleaning up after events that take place outside of the Sunday morning services.
- Grounds ALIVE uses volunteers to care for the church grounds each week. All training and equipment is provided.
- Safety -Provide a safe environment for services and other special events.
- Painters and Maintenance Assist with maintaining and updating facilities through painting and basic carpentry projects.
- Mercantile Assist with utilizing our land for the Farm and Orchard.

CAMPUS MINSITRIES

ALIVE wants to be a part of a multiplying movement so we are equipping leaders and preparing for future opportunities to plant, open campuses, and send out leaders. Currently we have four campuses, including our online campus!

 opportunities are available in teaching, greeting, tech, and behind-the-scenes crafting
 and curriculum prep.
- Worship Lead our congregation in meaningful worship, using your God-given gifts! Instrumentalists and vocalists are encouraged to reach out to join the team.

- Kids Tech Team Enhance our Big House and Treehouse worship experiences with lighting effects, sound control, screens, videos and other technical aspects needed for worship. Serves bi-weekly.
- AWSM Worship Team Help lead students in passionate worship of God through your gifts, excellence, and heart for God. This role is rotation based.
- AWSM Worship Tech Set the stage for worship, teaching, and fun through sound, media design, and meticulous execution of behin the scenes preparation.
- Front of House Sound Operates the soundboard and oversees the overall mix for the auditorium.
- Lighting Operates lighting console and programs lights to set the appropriate mood for worship.
- Auditorium Instrumentalist Serves in three auditorium services on Sunday mornings, as well as once a week practice.
- Auditorium Vocalist Serves in the three auditorium services on Sunday mornings, as well as once a week practice.

- Online Group Leaders Love connecting with others from afar? Sign up to creatively
 engage with people from ALIVE's online community through leading small groups, 4D
 conversations and more!
- Online Host Host an online worship service and help create community with our online congregation!

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GUEST CONNECTIONS

We are passionate about the spiritually hungry finding Jesus and their place in Christian Community. This is why we will be waiting at the drive way to help break down barriers people may have when attending church. People decide if they like a church within the first 7-10 minutes which means the sermon begins in the parking lot! There are places on this team for people with a variety of skill sets who are committed to having fun while serving guests at ALIVE.

CURRENT NEEDS:

- Greeters Greeters make a lasting impression as one of the first faces of ALIVE. Greeters do everything from open doors, help guests find their way around the building, give out guest gifts, answer questions and make meaningful connections with guests.
- Parking Team The parking team creates a safe, welcoming and fun environment as they coordinate/direct traffic flow throughout the morning.
 They assure guests have a great front row parking space.
- ALIVE Merchandise (a.k.a. "The Collective") Assist in managing inventory and the presentation of ALIVE merchandise. Help with sales and transitions.
- Midweek Sunday Preparation Prepare supplies and environments that Sunday AM volunteers will need to welcome and serve spiritually hungry guests.
- Seating Ushers Serve in the auditorium helping people locate seats, welcome people as they enter the auditorium, and help reduce anxiety for guests looking for a seat.
- ALIVE Grounds Barista Visiting a church can be intimidating, but a coffee bar feels familiar and inviting. Our baristas create a welcoming environment by providing and excellent space where a guest can find great coffee and smiling faces.
- Weekly Follow Up Team After our guest's visit we want to thank them for
 visiting and provide opportunities for them to connect at ALIVE. Assist in
 entering guest data into follow-up programs. Makes contact with guests who
 have questions or require further conversation throughout the week
 (postcards, emails, calls).

THE EXCHANGE

The Exchange is a small business ministry enterprise. It is a thrift store providing opportunities for spiritually hungry customers and volunteers to find a Christian Community inviting them to know the source of their love; Jesus. This small business ministry enterprise is also an opportunity for ALIVE to increase our resources with which we can meet the needs of our community.

ONGOING VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES:

- Handy Man/Woman Team Building displays or shelving, or refinishing furniture.
- Transportation Team Pick up donations and transport donated items to other locations.
- Assembly Team Unboxing and assembling furniture and store items.
- Landscaping and Gardening Create an inviting environment outside of The Exchange building.
- "Whatever it takes" Team Willing to serve where needed most.
- Customer Care Team Welcome customers into the store. Be available to talk and/or pray with people. Provide information to connect people with resources to meet tangible needs.
- Gadget Team Inspecting, testing, cleaning technology and gadgets before they are sold.
- Refresh Team Do you love washing, folding, and hanging clothing items? This team will launder donated clothing and prepare them for a new home.
- Movers and Shakers -Helping unload donations from people's cars and placing them in the appropriate locations. Ensure individuals receive their tax donations receipt. Help customers in need of assistance move purchased items to their cars.
- Department Specialists- Maintain specific areas of the store (books, shoes, children's clothing, sporting goods, tools, etc.).
- Organization Team If you love to create and maintain organized spaces and systems, this team is for you!
- Marketing Team- This team is comprised of individuals who enjoy any of the following: managing social media accounts, graphic design, writing, photography, social media analytics.
- Donations Team Sorting and categorizing donations when they arrive at The Exchange.
- Sales Team These friendly faces will be responsible for operating our check-out counter.
- Store Environment Team Help maintain an attractive store environment, create new creative displays and maintain clean fresh spaces.
- Store Managers These individuals will help lead volunteers and daily store operations on specific days of theweek.
- Tech Team Help set up, maintain and troubleshoot technology and hardware needed for the daily operations of The Exchange.

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WORSHIP

The Adult Worship Department exists to reach spiritually hungry people and introduce them to a personal relationship with Jesus Christ, through excellent worship environments. Our goal is that the worship environment we create pleases God, attracts people, and inspires faithfulness. From the tech booth to the platform, our teams use their gifts and talents to create a space where people are given different opportunities to bump into Jesus. Worship is not only using our voices to bring praise to our God, but it's using any gifts He's given us to bring glory to His name. If you want to be part of a fun team, that works hard to love people well, and create excellent worship environments so people churched and unchurched can bump into Jesus - this is the team for you! The Worship Department has several different serving opportunities we'd love for you to be a part of!

CURRENT NEEDS:

- Front of House Sound (FOH) Auditorium Oversees and operates the overall mix for the auditorium services.
- Front of House Sound (FOH) Chapel Oversees and operates the overall mix for the chapel services.
- Lighting Controls and helps program the lighting for each worship set.
- Video Director Responsible for all you see on the screens and through our online stream! These few are in charge of cueing (verbal direction) while running the video switcher. These people have an eye for detail, can multitask well, and can communicate clearly to a team.
- Computer Graphics (CG) Auditorium Responsible for making sure the appropriate slides are displayed during worship and the teaching time.
- Computer Graphics (CG) Chapel Responsible for making sure the appropriate slides are displayed during worship and the teaching time
- Camera Operator Captures the moments in the auditorium for our online congregants. This volunteer opportunity ranges from static cameras, to using a roaming camera for more close-up shots of the service.
- Instrumentalist Auditorium (Bass, Acoustic Guitar, Electric Guitar, Keys, Drums)
 Plays with the band for all three Sunday morning servies. Includes one rehearsal during the week.
- Instrumentalist Chapel (Traditional orchestral instrumentation) Plays in the Chapel services at 10:00 AM on Sunday mornings.
- Vocalist Auditorium Sings with the band in all three Sunday morning services.
 Includes one rehearsal during the week.
- Choir Chapel Sings in the Chapel service at 10:00 AM and attends a Sunday night rehearsal.
- Stage Hands Auditorium Moves props on and off the platform for the teaching time on Sunday mornings.
- Set Design Helps build and assemble set designs for the platform for new series and holidays.

ALIVE KIDS

In ALIVE Kids, we find creative ways for kids to learn about Jesus on their level, so they are begging to come back. We want kids to have fun, begin a relationship with Jesus, and be baptized before they leave ALIVE Kids.

It is our goal to reach the 10,000 kids in Pickens County and beyond who are currently unchurched and help volunteers use their gifts to make a life-long impact on the hearts of kids. If you love kids and love to have fun, ALIVE Kids is the place to be!

CURRENT NEEDS:

- Guest Services Team Be the first point of contact for brand new kids and families; provide the information on what to expect as they attend ALIVE and ALIVE Kids. Some roles within this team only serve during the "rush" between services. Serves bi-weekly.
- High-Five Club Think high-fives, smiles, welcomes, holding doors and greeting every kid
 and family as they come into our building! This role is crucial as it sets the tone of our
 environment with every high-five! Serves bi-weekly.
- Wheelies Team Every kid loves a wagon ride! Grab a wagon and help parents get their little ones into the building with a VIP wagon ride! This is a great role for children to serve in while their parents great at the doors or serve at the Guest Tent. Serves biweekly.
- Fun Squad Basically the best job in the building! Hang out on the Kids Terrace to assist
 and monitor kids safety as they have a blast on the slide and tunnel between services.
 Serves bi-weekly.
- Clubhouse Buddy A buddy provides care, support, and love to kids with special needs and/or sensory sensitivities while they are in ALIVE kids. This ministry allows parents to enjoy service and allows kids to know the love of Jesus! Serves bi-weeky/as needed with an assigned child.
- Big House SGL (Small Group Leader) Loves, leads, and connects with elementary kids through fun, activities, and snacks. Crazy fun required! Serves weekly.
- Treehouse SGL (Small Group Leader) Loves, leads, and connects with preschoolers through fun, activities, and snacks. Smiles and fun required! We prep all activities prior to your arrival - show up and SMILE! Serves bi-weekly.
- Treehouse Storyteller Teaches Bible stories and leads worship with preschoolers.
 Membership required. Serves bi-weekly.
- Treehouse Service Leader Administrates a team of bi-weekly volunteers. Keeps the hall running smoothly and greets new families. Serves bi-weekly.
- Tech Team Enhance our Big House and Treehouse worship experiences with lighting
 effects, sound control, screens, videos, and other technical aspects needed for worship.
 Serves bi-weekly.
- Packing Party Team It's a preschool packing party to help prep & pack supplies and crafts for the little's monthly activities. Parties are once a month.
- Stage Designer Are you creative and artsy? Help us transform our Big House (Elem) stage and lobby environments into something amazing the kids will be crazy about.
 Serves monthly-quarterly.
